Message from CEO

Although the Financial Notice to Improve was expected, it was only when we received it on Friday that the exact terms and conditions designed for Plymouth CAST became known. It is very clear that we shall have to act very swiftly as our action plan, which will set out the steps taken to address all the issues identified by the independent reviews of governance and financial management, pupil premium and safeguarding, needs to be submitted to the ESFA by 20th October. Our revised financial recovery plan needs to be written, and externally validated, before it is submitted to the ESFA by 17th November. We shall be communicating the next steps to you as soon as possible.

I am delighted that three co-opted directors have joined the board of CAST. They are Laura Sprackman, Terry Stockley and Graham Briscoe. They bring a wide range of experience and I'm sure they will be a great asset to the board.

I mentioned at our last conference at Exeter Racecourse that the RSC had recommended that an Enhanced Support Group be formed to provide advice and guidance to the board. The RSC recommended three of the members:

Alan Morris (who will chair the group); Carol Hannaford and Iain Grafton. Four members are directors of CAST – Fr Mark O'Keeffe, Maria Edwards, Andy Nicholls and Graham Briscoe. I will usually be in attendance. The first meeting was held in the afternoon of Friday 15th September and there will be fortnightly meetings on Fridays thereafter. I am sure that they will be very helpful, not least because Alan has already helped a trust facing similar problems to those we are experiencing.

Indoor Swimming Pool at St Mary's Penzance Re-opens

Demelza Bolton, Headteacher at St Mary's RC Primary School Penzance was delighted to be able to re-open the school's indoor heated swimming pool at St Mary's on Monday 25th September 2017 after three years of the pool being out of action. 'It has been a real community effort to get this pool open again', said the Head. 'I came to this school as a child, and can remember the pool being built and being opened for the first time'.

'The pool is a real asset to pupils at this school. We are the only primary school in Penzance with this facility, and opening the pool will enable us to provide all our pupils with swimming lessons, teaching them a 'skill for life'. Enquiries have already been made by other schools keen to hire the facilities to teach swimming their pupils, and a private swimming coach wants to hire out the pool three evenings a week to run lessons.

Parents and staff worked hard during school holidays to re-fiberglass the pool, and get it ready for use. One of the parents at the school who works as a teaching assistant and is also a swimming coach will now be spending part of her time running swimming lessons for pupils, and a meal time assistant who is a trained lifeguard now also has a dual role.

The school is planning to hold a formal opening in the next few weeks, and hope to invite a special guest, the 'mermaid of St Ives' to take part in the celebration, plus the local press.

'We are committed to enabling pupils in our school develop skills that will equip them for life'. Having a swimming pool on site provides our school with a unique opportunity to enhance learning opportunities for our pupils and young people in the wider community.
