# 1. Government Data - Pupil Absence Data 2016/17

Latest pupil absence date shows that the overall absence rate across state funded primary, secondary and special schools has remained at the same rate of 4.6% in 2015/16 as in the previous year. The overall absence rate has remained broadly stable since 2013/14. Illness remains the most common reason for absence, accounting for 57.3 per cent of all absences.

In 2015/16, persistent absentees accounted for 36.6 per cent of all absence compared to 37.4 per cent in 2014/15. Longer term, there has been a decrease in the proportion of absence that persistent absentees account for – down from 43.3 per cent in 2011/12.

Family holidays (authorised and unauthorised) accounted for 8.2 per cent of all absences in 2015/16 compared to 7.5 per cent in 2014/15.

Among ethnic groups, the highest overall absence rates were seen for Traveller of Irish Heritage and Gypsy/Roma pupil enrolments who had rates of 17.9 per cent and 12.7 per cent respectively. Enrolments of a Chinese and Black African ethnicity had the lowest overall absence rate of any ethnic groups, at 2.4 per cent and 3.0 per cent respectively, a substantially lower rate than the national average of 4.6 per cent.

#### Deals in the Pipeline (but not confirmed)

*Websites*: Roll up of all e-school websites to one cheaper contract. *Print*: Managed print service with Xerox. *Stationary*: Office Supplies contract with ESPO Framework providers. *Safeguarding*: Central contract with CPOMS. *Health and Safety*: Trust wide rollout of single system for monitoring and training (two preferred bidders – one of which already in use by 15 of our schools). *Catering*: New contracts for 2 Cornwall and 2 Devon schools for 1 Sep 2017.

#### 6. **EFA Condition Data Collection Surveys**

Reminder of the EFA Condition Data Collection Surveys. This is a 3 year project to assess national school estate conditions. Schools may therefore be contacted to host a half day visit (visual only – no testing or entering voids). At least 35 days notice will be given. Please notify your area adviser if you get a call so we can inform the Diocese who are our Landlord. This initiative is simply a survey; <u>not</u> an inspection – no judgement or grading.
